## Fun Facts about recycling that you or I didn't know:

**Cardboard or OCC or Old Corrugated Cardboard, can be recycled up to at least 7 times! Just make sure it is clean and flattened.**

**Aluminum can/Tin can: It takes 60 days for one aluminum can to be recycled and put back onto the grocery store shelf. Aluminum cans/tin cans be recycled over and over and over!**

**Plastic bottle facts: 2.5 Million plastic bottles are thrown away every hour in the U.S. alone. Reusable water bottles are the solution to the pollution.**

**Paper recycling: Each ton or 2,000 pounds of paper that is recycled can save 7,000 gallons of water!**
